#### **How to Record Your Video**

- 1. **Introduce yourself** Your name, title, and company.

- 3. **Highlight your COVESA experience** How has being part of the COVESA community benefited your organization?

## **Best Practices for Filming**

- **Length:** Keep it short—1-2 minutes is ideal.
- **Timing:** If possible, record early, before many attendees arrive, to minimize distractions and background noise.
- Lighting and Audio: When recording, be aware of the lighting and background noise. If available, bring tools like portable lighting (compact ring lights or clip-on LED lights) and a lapel or directional microphone to ensure better light and sound quality.
- Framing: Film horizontally and ensure your face and demo are both clearly visible.
- Stability: Use a tripod with a phone mount or a phone stand to avoid shaky footage.
- **Personal Touch:** Include yourself in the video to make it engaging while showcasing your demo.
